SUBJECT INCLUSION REQUIREMENTS:

- No history of unusual bleeding or bruising.
- If you are a blood donor, for example with the Canadian Blood Services or are participating in another study, you cannot participate in this study.
- You must have no history of HIV, liver disease (e.g., hepatitis) or any recent acute illness
- You must have no history of fainting or other bad effects when blood is drawn.
- You must be at least 18 or older and able to consent for yourself.
- You must have no knowledge that you are pregnant.
